

STEM Biomedical Student Research Grant Terms and Conditions

Issued on January 11th 2019

1. The research project to be conducted by the STEM Biomedical Student Research Grant recipient must be conducted at a Canadian post-secondary institution where the recipient is enrolled at either the masters or doctoral level.
2. The research project to be conducted by the STEM Biomedical Student Research Grant recipient must be performed under the supervision of a faculty member at the same institution as the recipient.
3. The total funding amount, \$1,000.00 CAD, must be used for laboratory materials pertaining to the proposed project. If the recipient requires use of the funding for anything other than laboratory materials, direct approval must be received from STEM Biomedical.
4. The total funding amount, \$1,000.00 CAD, must be used within one year from the date of receipt. Although the funding must be used within one year, the project timeline itself is not required to be limited to one year.
5. Any publication or presentation produced from the proposed project, or other research financially supported by the STEM Biomedical Student Research Grant, must include acknowledgement of funding contribution from STEM Biomedical.
6. STEM Biomedical does not claim any proprietary or intellectual ownership of the research project of the STEM Biomedical Student Research Grant recipient. STEM Biomedical does not claim any proprietary or intellectual ownership of the results or any other information obtained from the research project of the STEM Biomedical Student Research Grant recipient.
7. The STEM Biomedical Student Research Grant is not exclusive and may be used in conjunction with any other grant.
8. STEM Biomedical is not liable for any unethical or illegal research practices. It is the responsibility of the grant recipient to follow institutional regulations. It is the responsibility of the grant recipient to understand and abide by the laws and regulations set forth by the Government of Canada. STEM Biomedical does not support any research which violates any of the aforementioned governing laws and regulations.
